- Mr Ramkumar Siwach, who is in charge of the administrative section, stated that the college had sent a request to the Director of Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula, via letter no. NRS /GCR /2021/ 2781, dated, to set up a Math Computer Lab in the college; however, the college has not yet received a response to this request from the Director of Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula.
- The college has submitted a letter with the letter number PT NRS/GSR /2021/1664 and 1666 dated November 8, 2021, to the Director of General Higher Education in regards to the granting of a grant to establish a computer lab in the Mathematics Department and an IT-enabled seminar hall in the college.
- The IQAC has circulated a circular to the heads of the departments, in which it has requested that the heads of the departments invite their subject experts from their respective subjects to deliver extended lectures during the academic session.
- The IQAC Coordinator, in collaboration with Dr Sushil Arora, Assistant Professor in the Department of Physics, has designed Google Forms intending to collect feedback from students as well as parents. In total, there were around 1928 students and 1210 parents that took part in this process.
- On 10.09.2021, HODs and the timetable committee convened for a meeting. All the HODs are requested to submit the combinations of students' strengths so that a smooth timetable can be prepared.

An analysis of the feedback obtained from students as well as parents was conducted, and a report was compiled as a result. ACTION TAKEN REPORT OF MEETING 11.12.2021

On December 13, 2021, a staff meeting was conducted in the college auditorium to discuss The Zonal Youth Festival, which was scheduled to be held in the college between December 22 and December 24, 2021. The following is an outline of how the tasks were delegated to the various committees:

- ❖ All committee incharges were instructed to invite and process programme quotations
- ❖ The Registration Committee was asked to list the rooms for other college teams.
- ❖ The water arrangement committee was instructed to provide ample potable water.
- ❖ The committee requested office stationery needs from the incharges.
- Each stage's decoration committee was instructed.
- ❖ The sanitation committee provided sanitisers, masks, etc. The college campus was to be heavily fogged.
- ❖ The cleanliness committee was instructed to engage DC-rate labour for a few days to clean the college during the occasion.
- Principal Office and all-stage refreshment committees were instructed to prepare arrangements.
- Strict directions ensured event discipline.
- ❖ The discipline committee must be vigilant. Only I cards were to be checked and no others were permitted in without valid identification. For programme smoothness, Discipline Incharge was urged to seek police cooperation.
- ❖ The committee inquired about Flex/Banner.
- ❖ Volunteers were requested from NSS/NCC incharges.
- ❖ Staff prepared TA/DA Bills for judges at every level.
- ❖ The electricity committee was asked to verify light installations. 5. Certificate, invitation, and I card printing were checked.
- ❖ The incident had to be recorded/photographed without interruption. To prevent unfairness at the Youth Festival, the CCTV committee was instructed to monitor the situation.
- ❖ The Digital Resource Committee was asked to coordinate with stage incharges to collect and compile results.
- ❖ The invitation committee was instructed to invite dignitaries and notable public figures. Principal sir suggested that the staff invite reputable people from its circle/acquaintance and send their names to the invitation committee so they might attend the occasion.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT OF MEETING 03.02.2022

- The distribution of various responsibilities concerning the state-level science exhibition that will take place on February 8, 2022, has been finalized. To fulfil these obligations, several committees were formed, and both teaching and non-teaching members of the college were included in these committees.
- Since the Honourable Chief Minister is a former student of the college, IQAC arranged a meeting between her and the Alumni Association's officers.
- ❖ The Demand Letter for the College was Prepared by the Coordinator of the IQAC, and it included the Demand for a New Teaching Building as well as an Indoor Sports Complex.
- After being provided with a letter of demand from the college by its Respectable Principal, the Honourable Chief Minister approved it and announced payment in the amount of 780000000.
- ❖ On February 9, 2022, the college hosted a job fair at which 25 different companies displayed their offerings to interested students. Approximately 500 college students from a variety of institutions took part.

❖ The college's Political Science Department hosted a national seminar on the 12th of February 2022, and 300 people showed up from all around the state to take part.
